

NFRW RESOLUTION

Political Indoctrination

Whereas, using public education as a political weapon to train children to adopt the beliefs of one political Party (or movement) is political indoctrination and, the communist model of education where all learning is geared to achieving political goals and;

Whereas, extensive documentation confirms the environmental movement is using public education to impose a nationwide political indoctrination program by, **1)** shifting the focus of public education to environmental activism, **2)** using politicized curriculums (pre-K - 12th grade) to align children's beliefs and behaviors with the goals of this political movement, **3)** targeting and training our future voters to adopt beliefs that mirror communism and Green Party goals, and;

Whereas, politicized curriculums include Environmental Literacy, Climate Literacy, Education for Sustainability and Social Justice goals, and;

Whereas, the goal of Social Justice, to achieve "equality in the distribution of goods and wealth among all groups in a society", matches the definition of communism and, therefore teaching social justice as an environmental goal requires teaching students that **1)** all wealth and goods must be seized, controlled and distributed equally and, **2)** our form of government must be replaced with a dictatorial communist form of government in order to achieve social justice, and;

Whereas, the planned misuse of public education by the environmental movement to train America's children to be 'for' a communist form of government is a violation of the public trust that impacts parental rights, religious freedom, free speech, free enterprise, private property rights and national security, and;

Whereas, the U.S. Department of Education is using federal funds to inadvertently advance Education for Sustainability goals, which include changing the "cultural, religious, social, economic and political structure" of our nation, and;

Whereas, the National Federation of Republican Women agrees with the 'We Choose Freedom' campaign statement, "the American standard of a politically neutral (party neutral) public education is an essential safeguard to free thought, individual freedom and the democratic process, and we must ensure the education of America's youth is not compromised to impose the agenda of any one party".

RESOLVED, That the National Federation of Republican Women at its March 2017 meeting in Memphis, Tennessee, calls on the federal government to take immediate action to **1)** address the issues raised in this Resolution regarding the political indoctrination of America's children as a matter of national security, **2)** suspend all funding or appropriations for the environmental education programs listed in paragraph 3 (above) until the issue of political indoctrination can be addressed, concerns resolved and safeguards put in place, and;

RESOLVED, That the National Federation of Republican Women urges the U.S. Department of Education to immediately suspend all financial and promotional support for environmental education programs, including Green Ribbon School Awards, and publicly call for participating schools to voluntarily suspend these programs due to evidence of political bias, and be it further

RESOLVED, That the National Federation of Republican Women urges NFRW members to use this Resolution to inform others and to encourage elected officials to learn more about this issue (read *Training for Treason* by NFRW member Holly Swanson) and, help stop the political indoctrination of America's children.
